SECTION 01 10 00 – SUMMARY OF WORK

PART 1 - GENERAL

1.01 CONDITIONS OF THE CONTRACT

The conditions set forth in the Procurement Requirements, Conditions of the Contract, other Project Manual Divisions, the Construction Drawings, and related or included References are hereby made a part of this Section and apply to all work in this Section.

1.02 PROJECT

This Project shall generally include the work shown on Drawings related to the Plank Road Repairs at Mill Ruins Park. The Work shall include, but is not limited to:

- Mobilization(s)
- Erosion and Sediment Control
- Traffic Control – Design, Installation, Maintenance, Supervision; Flaggers
- Site Safety, Site Control, and Protection
- Signage
- Selective Demolition, Removals, Salvage, Delivery, Hauling, and Disposal/Recycling
- Earthwork and Drainage
- Locating Underground Utilities
- Concrete Work - Mix Design, Formwork, Rebar, Curbs, and Light and RRFB Post Footing Caps
- Wood Boardwalk
- Coordination for Mandatory Observation, and Mandatory Engineering Testing and Inspections
- Various Anchors, Fasteners, Epoxy Cement, Grout, and Incidentals to Attach and Fasten Components
- Electrical Work at Light Poles and RRFB
- Additional Class V aggregate
- Saw-cutting of metal and concrete and welding of rail and other items
- Painting / Striping
- Installation of RRFB footings
- Installation of RRFB Pedestal Assembly not in contract/installed by others
- Turf Restoration to include Seeding and Turf Establishment
- Miscellaneous Site Restoration

Work of the Project consists of all labor, materials, articles, submittals, equipment, incidentals, items, tools, services, supplies, methods, operations, warranties, verification, site utility investigations, and skills in such quantities as may be necessary to complete the project within the intent of the Contract Documents.

The Work shall also include but is not limited to:

- Allowing for minor changes in the work due to engineering reviews, conflicts with unforeseen conditions, and onsite inspections. This work is incidental when the change is minimal.
- Correct all work not in compliance with the documents, at Contractors own cost.
- Restore all amenities damaged by the Work, to Owner's satisfaction. Provide restoration for all damaged or damaged turf, plantings, pavements, and other site features. Minimize restoration to the smallest area necessary.
- Include heavy duty poly mats, or similar, for heavy equipment crossing root zones, turf, pathways, or other areas to minimize damage.
- Comply with architect and engineer directions, specifications, requirements, notes, and drawings - as applicable to the Work.
- Provide for protection of the work and temporary utilities.
- Provide provisions for wet, dry, cold, or hot weather.
- Provide temporary storage, as needed.
